We are currently starting a period that will result in deep modifications in the energy strategy, not only at an European Union level but also in the Spanish energy policy development.

In Europe, the Commission is working in a revision of the current high efficiency cogeneration Directive, and in a new Energy Efficiency Action Plan. Both documents will affect significantly the future cogeneration developments.

In Spain, energy is in the agenda of the following Government Action Plan. The planning of the energy Mix, together with the current updates in the frame in force, affects all the special regime development, including renewals and cogeneration.

Cogen Spain and Cogen Europe celebrate, this following month, its Annual Conferences in Madrid and in Brussels respectively. In both Conferences the future of CHP will be discussed.

Particularly, during the 8th ANNUAL CONFERENCE, that will be carried out in Madrid the 14th and 15th of March under the subject **“New ways for cogeneration in Spain”**, the necessary modifications of the legislation currently in force will be proposed, in order to accomplish with the objectives established in the Directive 2004/87CE. Also as part of the program, the 15th of March, members of other national member state associations will carry out the 4th CODE Regional Workshop. This second event is partially sponsored by the European Commission, and analyzes the implementation of the Directive 2004/8 in the different Member States.

Cogen Spain is promoting this 8th ANNUAL CONFERENCE as an opportunity to discuss the improvements and modifications to be introduced in our current policy to assure a feasible and reasonable growth for cogeneration. This growth has been frozen this last decade, despite of being the only technology available in the market that satisfies at the same time the three basic aims of the system: 1) Guarantee of supply; 2) Reduction of the emissions and 3) Economy and competitiveness for the industrial sector.
